Saturday, July 14th 9:00-5:30 at the Maplewood Rock and Gem Club Building

The Guild is once again sponsoring Mary Irvine Basket Day. This is a fun day for the Guild to provide a great learning opportunity for both members and their guests. The Guild pays the instructors' fees at \$35/hour, and students pay only the materials fee.

This year, we will again use the Maplewood Rock and Gem Club Building at 8802 - 196th St SW, Edmonds, WA. This location provides an indoor space with adequate lighting for classes and the possibility for full day classes lasting up to 7.5 hours, and half-day classes lasting 2, 3, or 4 hours.

If you have been thinking about teaching a class, this is your opportunity! You do not have to be a member of the Guild to propose a class, although first preference is given to Guild members. When designing your class(es), please remember that although we want to offer classes for a variety of skill levels and will have all experience levels signing up for classes, a large percentage of students could be beginners. In estimating the time for your class, please be sure to allow sufficient time for the project to be completed in the timeframe by a beginning to average weaver. Each class will require a minimum of 5 students to "go" with a maximum number of 8-12 students.

A sharp, clear photo as close as your camera will take with a white background works best for our illustrations. Your Proposal will not be considered without a photo!
